DATES: Wed, Aug 21 (Pairings Meeting), Saturday, August 24 – Sunday, August 25(Golf)

1. Costs
 - a. \$145 All-In entry fee per player, which includes:
 - i. Appetizers/Soda at Wednesday evening pairings meeting (Aug 21st)
 - ii. Event giveaway – hat – 2 styles, one for each team
 - iii. Greens Fees for Sat/Sun
 - iv. Prizes
 - b. Deadline to prepay in the pro-shop is Sunday, August 18th.
2. Format – all Match Play
 - a. Saturday
 - i. 2 – 9 hole matches
 1. Front Nine: Best Ball (both players play their own ball, record one team score)
 2. Back Nine: Modified Alternate Shot (both players tee off, choose which one ball to play the rest of the hole with by alternating shots between teammates)
 - ii. 1 point per 9 hole match
 1. 1 point for a match won
 2. 0.5 points for a match that is halved
 - b. Sunday
 - i. 2 – 9 hole individual matches
 - ii. 1 match against each competitor in foursome
 - iii. 1 point per 9 hole individual match
 1. 1 point for a match won
 2. 0.5 points for a match that is halved
 - c. In the Event of a Tie
 - i. Sudden Death playoff starting on #1
 - ii. 2 Man Scramble – Gross Score
 - iii. Captain will choose the 2 players from his team to participate
3. Teams/Pairings
 - a. Initial sign up will be for 24 players
 - i. We can expand teams in increments of 4 players should demand allow it
 1. e.g. 28 players, 32 players
 2. 40 players (20 person teams) will be the maximum
 - b. Players will be broken into 6 groups, A-G based on handicap (scaled as required if more than 24 players)
 - i. Goal is to minimize the amount of strokes given in a match so foursomes will be determined by handicaps
 - c. Within each of the 6 groups the 4 players will be randomly drawn onto the 2 teams, captained by Jeff and Erik
 - i. Each team consists of 2 players from each group
 - ii. “A” players will play “A” players; “B” players will play “B” players, etc.
 - d. The six groups will be drawn prior to the Pairings meeting. During pairings meeting, the teams will be announced.
 - e. We will target to play matches on a gross basis if handicap differentials are small. Otherwise, we will play net. Decision to be made after signups are complete.

4. Prizes

a. Prize Structure

- i. Total prize pool will be \$40 (\$25 from players, \$15 board subsidy) per player * 24 players = \$960
- ii. Prizes paid in pro shop credit
- iii. Pool divided in 2 ways
- iv. \$50 for each member of the winning team ($\$50 * 12 = \600)
- v. Remaining \$360 will be paid out to 3 best performing teams during competition
 1. 1st Place: \$180 (\$90 per player)
 2. 2nd Place: \$100 (\$50 per player)
 3. 3rd Place: \$80 (\$40 per player)
 4. If 2 teams are tied for 1st place, \$280 will be split evenly between the 2 teams, \$140 each (\$70 per player). Same procedure for other ties within the top 3.
 5. Only 3 teams will be paid, so if there is a tie for 3rd place (or a 3 way tie for 2nd, or a 4 way tie for first, etc.) the tiebreaker procedures documented in section 4.a.vi. will be used.
- vi. Determination of top performing teams (and tiebreakers)
 1. Total points earned (maximum of 4.0 (1.0 for alt shot, 1.0 for best ball, 2.0 for individual matches))
 2. Total points earned in Individual matches
 3. Total margin of victory in Individual matches (e.g. if team wins both matches, 3&2 and 2&1 the total margin of victory is 5). If a player wins a match 2up, it will be worth 1.5 points as 2&1 is a stronger victory than 2up and should be awarded as such.
 4. Total points earned in Best Ball
 5. Total points earned in Modified Alternate Shot
 6. Coin Toss

5. Sign-Ups

- a. First come, first serve
- b. Done through Sign Up Genius (similar to how Putting Contest and Interclub were done)
- c. 24 spots in the event will be available
- d. Sign-ups will open on Saturday, August 3rd at 5:30am
- e. Should demand warrant it, additional team spots will be opened up once event is booked to capacity
