

LOCAL RULES

- STONES IN BUNKERS are loose impediments under Rule 12.2a.
- **CART PATH EXTENSIONS:** Free relief from cart path extensions

• DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

Players are allowed to use devices that measure distance only under Rule 4.3. However, you may not use features that gauge or measure other conditions that might affect a player's play (e.g. wind, gradient, temperature, etc.). Penalty for first breach from single act: Two Shot Penalty, Penalty for second breach: Disqualification.

OUT OF BOUNDS

Out of bounds is defined by the white stakes and includes the railroad tracks on holes 3, 7, and 17. It is also defined by the parking lot and streets and by white stakes left of hole 17 by the maintenance barn and house.

BARNS ON 2 AND 10 ARE NO PLAY ZONES

If the condition (barn) interferes with the player's lie, stance or intended area of his swing, FREE relief can be taken without penalty under 16.1 as follows:

Relief: Lift and drop within one club-length of and not nearer the hole than the nearest point of relief on a part of the course, which avoids interference by the condition.

Relief is not available if the barn obstructs the "line-of-flight" that the player intends to hit his ball on.

• PENATLY AREAS ON 1, 9, 13 & 14

The wooded area within the boundaries defined by the red stakes on the right of holes 1, 13 & 14 and in front of hole 9 is to be treated as a RED PENALTY AREA. A ball lost in this area is considered to be lost within the penalty area. The player may take relief as described in Rule 17-1.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR

All areas deemed to be ground under repair will be properly marked. Unmarked areas of the course are to be treated as "rub of the green" and must be played as it lies.

• FLOWER BEDS LEFT OF HOLE 1 AREE NO PLAY ZONES

"The flower bed left of #1 is a NO PLAY ZONE from which play is prohibited. If a player's ball lies in the zone, or if it interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the player must take FREE relief under Rule 16.1 as follows:

Relief: Lift and drop within one club-length of and not nearer the hole than the nearest point of relief on a part of the course, which avoids interference by the condition.
